

Paracetamol Administration Consent Form February 2016

Dear Parent/Carer

Paracetamol/Calpol is the only medicine that the school keeps for general use. For a child to be given the medicine, written permission is needed in advance to be held on file at school and then verbal permission obtained on the day. All doses will be recorded and a slip sent home notifying you of the dose and time of administration.

Other than Calpol the school does not keep any medicines for general use.

Should your child be unwell at school and you would wish an authorised member of staff to be able to administer paracetamol to your child, please fill in this form and return to the school office.
