My favourite memory was in year two because we did the starry night pictures and we got to use pastels. My best part of it was the moon because it looked as if it was shining.



My favourite memory of Archibald was when I went to the Lee Sterry tournament .




My favourite memory was we did our year4 production .I played the of Helen of Troy I had to dance and sing a solo. It was so much fun performing it for the parents.

he played with me.


My favourite memory of Archibald was on the Centre for Life trip I really enjoyed ice skating and I learned how to but it was really slippy and I fell over A LOT !!!

My favourite memory was going on the rainbow table with George.


