Literacy

- Read a selection of books (to yourself, to a brother / sister / friend / parent)
- Write a book review
- Write a poem of your choice based on a style you have studied in school (haiku, cinquain, acrostic, rhyming, kennings etc.)
- Revise some of the tricky spellings that are in your homework book
- Write an adventure story
- Write a diary account from the point of view of a character in a story
- Write a conversation between two characters, practising your direct speech punctuation
