### **21<sup>st</sup> June - Class 8 Swimming Lessons**

Class 8 will begin their block of swimming lessons at Gosforth Pool on Monday 21<sup>st</sup> June 2021.

The pool's new model to ensure all children in KS2 have a chance to learn to swim is hour long lessons, Monday to Friday for two weeks. This model has proven to be a more effective delivery as the consecutive days make it easier for the children to remember, provides more time in the water and ensures a higher level of active learning.

Therefore, from Monday 21<sup>st</sup> June for a two-week period, Class 8 will swim between 2pm – 3pm. The children will need to be collected later from school at 3.30pm.

Please note that swimming is a key part of the PE curriculum and as such, children must attend each session unless they are unwell and have a [letter from your GP](#).

In order to comply with the swimming pool regulations, your child must bring their swimming cap with them to each session, together with their swimming costume/trunks (no bikinis or tankinis) and towel. **A cap will be provided** at the beginning of your child's block of lessons, but if lost, a replacement will need to be purchased by you.

Gosforth Pool has a **no jewellery policy**. No child will be allowed to swim wearing earrings. It is your responsibility to remove earrings before school on swimming days, together with any other jewellery.

Hair must also be tied back.

Please also note that as the children have to walk to the pool, **rain or shine**, they should bring a **suitable coat** with them **every swim day**.

### **Request: Helpers for Swimming**

Depending on staffing, we may need your help to escort the children to the pool and back each day. If you are able to spare the time on a rota basis, please email into the office at [admin@archibald.newcastle.sch.uk](mailto:admin@archibald.newcastle.sch.uk) indicating which day/s you are able to help if needed and helpers will be picked at random.

All helpers **MUST** have a valid DBS for safeguarding. Once a list of volunteers has been collated a rota will be pulled together. Mrs Carr will then contact you via email with a link for you to complete the DBS process. The valid certificate **MUST** be shown to Mrs Carr before you are able to help with the swimming lessons.

Please reply by Monday 19th April if you are able to help and agree to complete the DBS process.
