



Cullercoats Safety Rules and Guidelines

Please help us to make Cullercoats a fun and safe day by following our guidelines.

Arriving on the beach:

- Children to sit near their class flags

Whistle

- When the whistle blows ALL children must return to their class line for a name and head count
- Please help us by keeping siblings to one side and ensuring all children go to their class quickly
- No class is sent off to play until all the children have been accounted for

Water:

- Members of staff will be on duty in the water
- No child is to go into the water past their knees

Clothing and sun cream

- Apply sun cream to your child before coming to school
- Send sun cream to be reapplied throughout the day
- A light weight high-vis tabard will be provided for each child and **must** be worn at all times.
- **All children must wear a t-shirt with sleeves under their hi-vis vest all day**
- Remember to send spare clothes and a towel

Lunchtime

- Children are to remain seated throughout the lunch break
- **No one** is to go near the water or down the beach to play until the whistle is blown for the end of lunch
- Food and snacks can only be eaten at the designated lunch break

Your help on the day is very much appreciated and we look forward to seeing you there enjoying the day with the children



Cullercoats Safety Rules and Guidelines

Flags

- Children must stay seated with their class beside their class flag

Cones

- The cones show the boundaries for the children and where they will be seated.

Lifeguards

- The lifeguards patrol the beach at Cullercoats

Toilets

- These are located up the ramp. Staff **MUST** accompany children to the toilet
- No child is to go alone and no one is to be taken to the toilet without express permission from the class teacher. This ensures we know where the children are should the whistle be blown and a headcount

Adults

- Please set up your beach camp outside of the class areas.
